

MEDIA COORDINATOR

Sewanee Summer Music Festival

Job Overview

The Media Coordinator is primarily responsible for recording audio and video of all major Festival concerts, as well as running live streams of these concerts. Additional video work may include filming interviews with students, faculty, and conductors, and creating promotional video content. The Media Coordinator will also be responsible for running lighting and sound for all concerts, and coordination with the Production Manager to meet any additional technical needs of Festival performances.

Primary Responsibilities and Duties

- Record high-quality audio and multi-camera video of concerts.
- Manage livestream, and run a live multi-camera broadcast.
- Edit all concert video, and coordinate with Festival staff for upload to YouTube and Social Media.

Secondary Responsibilities and Duties

- Maintain the lighting system, and provide appropriate lighting for all concerts.
- Provide basic sound reinforcement for all concerts and events (generally this will be limited to pre-show announcements and conductors' announcements).
- Film and edit additional video content such as interviews and promotional materials.
- Coordinate any additional technical needs for select performances (such as sound playback or amplification).
- Other production and support duties as assigned.

Qualifications

Ideal Candidate will have:

- Experience in audio recording and streaming, including live streaming from YouTube and Wirecast.
- A background in classical music and the ability to read/understand scores.
- Experience with video recording, knowledge of BlackMagic ATEM Production Studio preferred.

- Experience in basic live sound, knowledge of the Yamaha QL1 console preferred
- Basic lighting knowledge, experience with Eos family consoles preferred

Compensation

- Hourly wage (commensurate with experience), plus on-campus housing and meals.
